



The Danville Independent Schools value and support National Board Certification.

WHY?

It's what's best for kids.

Over a decade of research across settings demonstrates that National Board Certified Teachers (NBCTs) have more impact on student growth. NBCTs have between **1-2 months of extra growth** with students each year and are **3 times more likely to engage students in deeper learning**. Student impact is even greater with students of color and students from lower income families.

HOW?

- Providing substitute teachers (one day per component for a total of four days) for preparation release days;
- Supporting candidates through a cohort model led by NBCT teacher leaders;
- Reimbursing the cost of candidacy for up to \$1500: \$250 reimbursement after the initial submission of each of the four components for total of up to \$1,000, and an additional \$500 after achieving certification; and,
- Continuing to pay all current NBCTs the annual \$2,000 state-mandated stipend, and the additional \$500 annual district stipend regardless of assigned role in the Danville Independent School District or available funds via state reimbursement.

WHAT?

National Board is relevant and flexible. Study your students and refine your practice.

The four components of Board Certification can be completed in any order or combination:

- Content Knowledge: computer-based assessment
- <u>Differentiation in Instruction</u>: portfolio entry with student work as evidence
- <u>Teaching Practice and Learning Environment</u>: portfolio with evidence of videotaped instruction
- <u>Effective and Reflective Practitioner</u>: portfolio demonstrating your knowledge of students through assessment data

WHEN?

Candidates have up to three years to submit all four components for the first time.

If needed, components can be resubmitted within a total of five years from starting candidacy.

Components are submitted each year in May.
