Primary Drivers	Change Ideas
A. School Vision	 Identify National Board resources and/or Board certification as strategies to improve student learning goals in school improvement plan. Anchor professional growth plans in National Board standards and/or Board certification. Use the "What Teachers Should Know and Be Able to Do" book and accompanying protocols to identify growth areas and supports needed to realize vision. Map leadership assets through the lens of National Board resources to support the school vision.
B. Collaborative professional learning	 Develop a common understanding of accomplished teaching practice through the "What Teachers Should Know and Be Able to Do" book. Support teachers in developing a common understanding of accomplished teaching using ATLAS. Engage teams with protocols and tools to support practice improvement cycles (Architecture of Accomplished Teaching, Plan, Do, Study, Act cycles etc.) Support teachers pursuing Board Certification in school based cohorts.
C. Public practice	 Analyze accomplished teaching through video cases (ATLAS) to develop a sense of safety for teachers in public examination of teaching practice. Use protocols based on the 5 Core Propositions when observing teaching of peers via lesson study, instructional rounds etc.
D. Planning and assessment	 Use the Architecture of Accomplished Teaching and National Board Standards to keep instruction centered on your students and their needs. Use the Architecture of Accomplished Teaching to examine student work, reflect on student learning, and the effectiveness of the instructional design.
